HOUSES FOR HAITI: WHO WE ARE

Houses For Haiti was founded in 2008 by Diane Albright and her sister Linda Satriano. It is an All Volunteer organization with 98% of its donations going to projects. Houses For Haiti is dedicated to building houses for homeless families living on the streets of Cite Soleil, the poorest slum in the Western Hemisphere. With no jobs, education, or public assistance, many families have no hope for ever living in a concrete dwelling. We believe that every person deserves to live in a safe environment, free from disease and filth that is ever-present on the streets of Haiti. To date, we have built 26 houses. Our goal is to build two houses each year with each house costing \$5,000. We also began sponsoring seven children's education in just the last year. There are various ways you can support us. Bring your used Ink Cartridges to the Church and put them in the basket in the Narthex; use Goodsearch.org when surfing the internet and put Houses For Haiti in as the cause you are supporting; pray for us; participate in our annual bowling fundraiser; or make a donation either online at Housesforhaiti.org or by mail. Beginning November 4, you can also bring in your spare change and put it in the containers on the tables during fellowship time. We are starting a new program where the 1st Sunday of every month you will have the opportunity to bring in your change, to Change Haiti.

Houses For Haiti is hosting its 11th Annual Bowling Tournament and Silent Auction/Raffle at Concord Lanes *(Formerly Mattie's Bowl)* on Sunday, **November 11th**. Registration is at 12:00pm, bowling starts at 12:30pm. The cost is \$20 for adults and \$10 for children under 18, which includes 3 games of bowling, shoes, and a chance to win fabulous prizes. We are raising money to build houses for homeless people in Cite Soleil, Haiti, the poorest slum in the Western Hemisphere. Registration forms can be found in the Gathering Space.
