Christ Candle: The Christ candle is lit because Jesus is Emmanuel, God with us. Jesus promised to never leave or forsake us. In time Jesus will make all Christmas wishes come true and last for eternity.

Peace Candle: We relight the candle of peace which could also be called the candle of grace and forgiveness. God forgives, heals and retells our stories. Whatever you have done, whatever you have failed to do, whoever you are, whoever you wish you were but are not: You are accepted, you are welcomed. You belong. You are washed clean, you are raised up. You are forgiven, you are set free. In the love of Jesus Christ, you are loved forever. God knows all. God knows you completely and God loves you eternally. God cares for you. God is comforting you. Your complete and total forgiveness creates peace within, enabling you to fully love yourself, which enables us to forgive each other, so we can love each other, ushering in peace on earth. Jesus is the Prince of Peace.

Hope Candle: We relight the candle of hope proclaiming that Jesus the light shines in the darkness and the darkness will never overcome the light. Relax, let hope sink into your being to rejuvenate you. On the surface the world is still in chaos, yet under the surface everything has changed and will be glorious. Hope flows from God. It is not your job to muster up a Christmas spirit. God does it for you. Let go. Imagine Jesus enveloping you in hope that is drawing you into an ever-increasing life of love and joy.

Love Candle: We relight the candle of Love that endures forever. Absolutely nothing can every separate us from God's love. Every instance of love you received and share is eternal. We know love because God first loved us. We know God is with us because we all have experienced love. God is love. Those who abide in love, abide in God and God abides in them. For God so loves the world that God sent Jesus for you. Jesus is the author of love.

<u>Joy Candle</u> We relight the candle of joy. God is joy. Jesus is with you filling you with God's joy that creates and redeems, God's joy that delights in you, God's joy that is drawing the cosmos together in unity, God's joy that will cause us to dance, sing and radiate the glory of God. Let us receive again God's joy that fulfills all your pure desires even better than your grandest dreams, that revives all your lost loves even lovelier than you knew, that completes you and makes you whole, a glorious, eternal member of God's family, who belongs to the kingdom of God. Carol: "What Child is This"

Intro to John 1:1-14; Luke 2:1-20

The whole creation is on tiptoe to see the wonderful sight of Jesus' coming reign to be fully manifest. The wounded world aches with longing for the healing Jesus brings. Jesus comes revealing God's salvation plan for us and the cosmos. Faith moves us to look beyond our current world for the fulfillment of our deepest desires and hopes. "Christmas is a fest of the senses! It is a celebration of our ability to see, know, taste and touch the glory of God."

We are celebrating that the Word, that is Jesus, did indeed become flesh; pitched a tent among us; moved into our neighborhood. God threw love-light into a fallen, broken world to save and fix all. Jesus came to feel what we feel, live as we live. God has a passionate desire to be with each person, to kindle their love-light into a blaze. Jesus came for you. God came to throw love-light into your messy, sometimes scary world so you can perceive God's loving, illuminating presence. Jesus came to restore you to your true self, glorious inside and out. Jesus is the dawn of redeeming grace. Hear the gospel accounts of Christmas, heaven reaching to you, the birth of Jesus.

A reading from the Gospels of John and Luke

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. Jesus was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Jesus, and without Jesus not one thing came into being. What has come into being in Jesus was life, and the life was the light of all people. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it. In those days a decree went out from Emperor Augustus that all the world should be registered. This was the first registration and was taken while Quirinius was governor of Syria. All went to their own towns to be registered. Joseph also went from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to the city of David called Bethlehem, because he was descended from the house and family of David. He went to be registered with Mary, to whom he was engaged and who was expecting a child. While they were there, the time came for her to deliver her child. And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in bands of cloth, and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.

The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world. Jesus was in the world, and the world came into being through Jesus; yet the world did not know Jesus. He came to what was his own, and his own

people did not accept Jesus. But to all who received Jesus, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God, who were born, not of blood or of the will of the flesh or of the will of people, but of God. In that region, there were shepherds living in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. Then an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for see - I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be a sign for you: you will find a child wrapped in bands of cloth and lying in a manger." And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host, praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace among those whom he favors!" When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let us go now to Bethlehem and see this thing that has taken place, which the Lord has made known to us." So they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the child lying in the manger. When they saw this, they made known what had been told them about this child; and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds told them. And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth. From Jesus fullness we all receive, grace upon grace. But Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart. The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them.

When we feel hopeless, Hope is caring for us and transform us. Abundant life is coming. I join the Apostle Paul in praying for you and everyone that God the source of hope will fill you completely with joy and peace, then you will overflow with confident hope.
