Remember singing?!? This summer we will return to in-person singing in Meisenheimer Hall.


If you like to sing hymns or anthems and are fully vaccinated, we would love to have you as part of the music ministry this summer. There are two options available.

Masks

Self-Health Check-up

Self-Health Check-up before entering the building or being present on grounds.

Please you must stay home if:

You have any of the following symptoms:

- Fever greater than 100 degrees
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Persistent cough
- Persistent pain or pressure in your chest
- New loss of taste or smell
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Sore throat
- Persistent headache
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea

If you have not been vaccinated and you have reasonable suspicion that you:

- Have been around someone who has tested positive for COVID-19
- Have been around someone suspected of having COVID-19

Sunday Worship--Physical in-person

Outside, Meisenheimer Hall or Sanctuary

<u>9am Outside (Weather Permitting) (Singing Encouraged) (Masks Optional) (Distancing Optional)</u>

When conditions are dry, we will livestream worship to a 65-inch television and a robust speaker outside. The outside worship area is under the large shade tree in the labyrinth area. The television is mounted on the east wall of Meisenheimer Hall. Access this area by walking around the east end of the sanctuary or through the building exiting the door adjacent to the Fireside Room. Masks optional. Singing encouraged. Physical distancing optional. You may bring your own chair or blanket or use the provided folding chairs. There will be a basket outside for your offering. No Child Care. Single use crayons, coloring and activity sheets will be available in the Gathering space for children.

9am Meisenheimer Hall (Singing Encouraged) (Masks Optional) (Distancing Optional)

You are welcome to join us for worship in Meisenheimer Hall where the music, liturgy and sermon is live and in person. Please do not stand between the camera on the corner of the media booth and the stage. Masks optional. Singing encouraged. Physical distancing optional. There will be a basket by the door for your offering. No Child Care. Single use crayons, coloring and activity sheets will be available in the Gathering space for children.

9am Sanctuary (No Singing) (Masks Required) (Distancing Required)

We will livestream worship into the sanctuary through the sound system and project on a large screen. The screen will be removed on September 19 when we anticipate resuming live 9 am Traditional and 10:45 Praise worship. Please sit every other pew to maintain 6 feet of physical distance between households. There will be a plate by the Sanctuary door for your offering. No Child Care. Single use crayons, coloring and activity sheets will be available in the Gathering space for children.

The Lord's Supper will be celebrated during 9am worship the first Sunday of the month. The Lord's Supper is a visible sign of what scripture proclaims as God's redeeming grace offered to all people. The Holy Spirit makes the Lord's Supper a nourishing, holy mystery. You are welcome to celebrate the Lord's Supper anytime at home with any type of food or beverage. Please celebrate the Lord's Supper as part of your worship experience. Worship speaks of God's grace through prayer, song, scripture, sermon, confession, and forgiveness. Most Presbyterians believe there is a synergy in celebrating the Lord's Supper as part of a worship service. On a Lord's Supper Sunday in-person worshipers will be given a sealed disposable cup of juice with a wafer upon entering the worship area.
